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# I SEPERATE WASTE,

## PAPER WASTE CONTAINERS

### **Throw:**

newspapers, magazines, pamphlets, catalogues, letters, books, cardboard, paper bags

### **DO NOT throw:**

~~cartons, plastic bags, tissues, laminated paper, used tissues, serviettes and nappies, paper plates and cups, photographs, stickers, damp or rotten paper or cardboard, dirty paper~~



Look for the blue container on green islands and public areas or the blue bag

## PLASTIC WASTE CONTAINERS

### **Throw:**

empty bottles, oil and vinegar bottles, fabric softener, shampoo and hair conditioner bottles, PVC packaging of food products (bottles, cups, boxes, bags, cellophane, coasters, cartons), plastic caps and lids, plastic cutlery, straws, CD and DVD boxes, protective plastic packaging or foils, plastic toys (that do not contain other materials)

### **DO NOT throw:**

~~motor oil, pesticide and insecticide packaging, wallpaper, styrofoam, sponges, toothbrushes, cables (power, internet), umbrellas, sports balls, lighters~~



Look for the yellow container on green islands and public areas or the yellow bag

# BECAUSE I LOVE ZADAR!



## GLASS WASTE CONTAINERS

### **Throw:**

empty glass bottles of all colours,  
without caps

### **DO NOT throw:**

~~porcelain and ceramic crockery, lightbulbs,  
fluorescent pipes, automotive glass,  
mirrors, crystal and optic glass  
reinforced glass, laboratory glass,  
glass wool~~

Look for the marked containers  
located on green islands



## BIODEGRADABLE WASTE CONTAINERS

### **Throw:**

kitchen waste (fruit and vegetable peel, eggshells, coffee dregs,  
teabags, bread, leafy vegetables), garden or green waste,  
cotton, hair and body hair

### **DO NOT throw:**

~~remains of cooked fruit and vegetables, bones, meat, fish,  
ashes, vacuum cleaner dust, dairy products, oils and fats  
painted and lacquered wooden waste, clothing and cigarettes,  
nappies, remains of litterbox sand~~

Look for the brown container next to the containers  
for mixed municipal waste



# SHOOT IN THE RIGHT BASKET!



Zadar is known as “**BASKETBALL CITY**”, and its citizens have been living and breathing this sport since the 1920s, which is when it arrived in our city. Watching basketball matches is a past-time enjoyed by children, youth and adults alike, and Zadar is also the hometown of many famous basketball players.

**THE SEA ORGAN** represents an intriguing and original fusion of architecture and music. The beautiful sound of the organ is made by the sea, that is, by the waves and shifting tides. It is located on the western part of the boardwalk (Riva), in the vicinity of the Monument to the Sun.

**THE MONUMENT TO THE SUN** is a one-of-a-kind installation that looks its best in the evening, which is when the real show begins - a spectacular play of light and colour.

**THE CHURCH OF ST DONATUS** is the most valuable monument of pre-Romanesque architecture of the Early Middle Ages (9th century AD) and it is the symbol of the city of Zadar. Its distinctive shape makes it one of the most important churches of its kind in Europe.
